3. **Public Comment:** Sharon Burke, Hal Bailey, Marilyn Bailey, Dan De Rensis, Andrea Scott, spoke on concerns over the home invasion reported on Crest Drive among other issues regarding police/sheriff coverage of the Alamo area. Lt. Warren reported that the Crest Avenue incident was not a random act.

- A. CHP Officer Pruitt: Office Pruitt commented on the larger number of residents in attendance, “it is good to get community input”. He mentioned that he was working with the parents of Rancho Romero students in regards to La Serena Way.
- B. Deputy Jesus Topete: The January 2015 Monthly Report was presented. Deputy Topete stated that burglaries were down to just one during January less than half what they were in December. The one burglary was on Sugar Loaf Terrace. The home was vacant and under new construction. The property stolen was a paint sprayer. The Deputy also report that the Jay (Justice) Team was active on one Saturday Evening in January. The “J” Team is a proactive team that is designed to travel throughout the community to deter crime. Deputy Topete wanted to remind all Alamo residents to keep their homes and vehicles secure to further deter future burglaries.
