1. Call to order: Chair Joe Motta called the meeting to order at 5:01PM.

2. Public Comment: None

3. Review and Approval of prior meeting minutes: Previous P2B Advisory Committee were reviewed with "all in favor". Joe Motta suggested motion to approve and seconded by Diane Barley. Motion carried unanimously.

5. Community Organizations Reports:

A. Diane Barley reported that the Alamo Rotary Club held its annual Easter egg hunt on March 31st at Livorna Park. Deputy Jesus Topete reported that his patrol car was on site and plenty of Sheriff Stickers were given out to the kids. Diane Barley stated that the local Fire Dept. truck was also in attendance. Deputy Jesus Topete participated while on PTO, thus showing dedication to the community.

B. AIA- Joe Rubay noted that the EBMUD towers are of concern to neighbors over appearance and height (water tank communications).

#### 6. Police Report:

Deputy Jesus Topete: There was a report of a shoplifting by 3-6 subjects at ACE Hardware. A search is currently underway for the perpetrators. The ALPR cameras are being used to track the subject vehicle with unique markings. Security cameras were taken from the store.

A car pursuit on Livorna Road was noted after a traffic stop was initiated. The car crashed and the subject foot-bailed and was apprehended. ALPR cameras tracked the subject to adjacent burglaries in Walnut Creek.

A smash and grab burglary of a vehicle parked in front of Peets Coffee and a laptop was taken from a black Audi.

A Safety Fair is set for May 12<sup>th</sup> at RHCC (LT Haynes to provide further updates as the event nears). Overtime was approved for an additional deputy at the Safety Fair.

A protest was noted at Rancho Romero elementary school and was handled by LT Haynes.

#### 7. On-Going Items:

A. Lieutenant Jason Haynes reported that ALPR Cameras are helping with crime research in the area.

B. Lieutenant Jason Haynes reported that the ACE Hardware shop lifting incident is under further investigation.

C. LT Haynes stated that Star Chase is going very well.

#### 8. Future Items:

-Increase the parcel tax- No report. Diane Barley motioned to keep the subject on the agenda (second by Bill Wilson).

-Sheriff Substation sign needs improvements. LT Haynes to speak with the landlord about sign renovations. Propose to have signs installed directing citizens to the Substation location.

-Round-about is 35% complete on the design phase. 2020 break ground per Jen Quallick. MAC meeting to finalize in the fall timeframe.

-Additional need for additional deputies to remain on the on-going agenda (per Joe Motta).
