The meeting was called to order at 5:05pm by Chair Joe Motta. In attendance were Diane Barley, Jo Ann Hirsch, Karen McPherson, Steve Nelson, Bill Nelson, Dave Dolter, and Anne Struthers. Staff present: Donna Maxwell (Supervisor Andersen's office) and CC County Sheriff Lt. Warren and Deputy Mike Carson. Public guests: Sharon Burke, Jeff Hebel, Danielle Bell, Ray Riordan, and Public Works staff Monish Sen. Supervisor Andersen was also in attendance.

It was requested and approved to alter the order of the agenda to accommodate staff and reports.

CHP Officer Brewer reported that one officer has been added to the CRT team, Tom Maguire, who is working on the south end and also covering Livorna and Stone Valley areas.

Supervisor Andersen introduced Ray Riordan, Emergency Manager for San Ramon who presented information on the San Ramon Valley Emergency Preparedness Citizen Corps Council. (see handouts) Mr. Riordan explained the 3 main benefits of being part of the SRVEP Citizens Corps Council as:

- 1) reduction of duplication of resources and efforts,
- 2) enhancing the strengths each area brings to the council,
- 3) strength in working together in unified manner.

The Council would like to include Alamo in the quarterly meetings to have a "voice" in the actions of the Council. A Joint Powers Authority is to be formed, and needs funding to be created. The formula for funding is not yet created, but it was estimated that it would cost approx. \$10K from APSAC funds. The Board discussed the benefits of emergency preparedness.

Motion: Move to support joining the SRVEP Citizen Corps Council contingent upon the P5 also joining and an equitable funding formula, up to an 80/20 ratio of shared costs with the P5. Barclay/seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Monish Sen (Public Works Traffic Engineer) presented information on traffic calming and speed feedback signs, and the pros and cons. He stressed the “3E” approach: Education, Enforcement, and Engineering. Officer Carson also gave his input.

Motion: It was moved to have Mr. Sen evaluate and consider the options and give a quote at the next meeting for lighted pedestrian crosswalk signage and lighting system for mid-block placement at Alamo Plaza. Barclay/seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion: It was moved to have Mr. Sen consider and identify the most advantageous location for speed-activated signage on north and southbound Danville Blvd., as it borders the downtown of Alamo. Barclay/seconded. Motion carried/1 opposed. Dave Dolter asked about better red light options for the right turn light on Stone Valley Blvd. Mr. Sen will bring back options at the next meeting.

Public Comment

Dick Olsen (Alamo Rotary) spoke regarding the beautification project \$63,000 for maintenance by Cal-Trans. Donna Maxwell will give quotes for cost of signage. AIA – Car Show on Sept. 5th, 4-8pm. There will be a disc jockey.

Minutes: The minutes from the last meeting were reviewed and corrections made: Ms. Barclay has not been emptying the P.O. Box; Mr. Nelson was present at the April meeting.
