1. **Call to order:** Chair Joe Motta called the meeting to order at 5:12 pm.

2. **Public Comment:** None.
3. **Review and Approval of Prior Meeting Minutes.** Motion to approve of the May 4, 2015 meeting, Motion was made by Diane Barley, Seconded by Cesare Ciatti, Motion carried unanimously.

6. **Community Organization Reports**
 - A. Alamo Improvement Association (AIA) – Joe Rubay reported that the AIA will be sponsoring a public town hall meeting on Pipeline Safety on June 3, 2015 at 6:30 pm at Creekside. Joe Rubay, reminded the committee that AIA has been sponsoring the Alamo Farmer's Market held in the Alamo Plaza (near the Bank of America building) on Sunday mornings from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm. The Farmer's Market is now open for the Spring and Summer.
 - B. Alamo Rotary Club – Diane Barley reminded the committee that the Alamo Rotary Club will not be sponsoring the Alamo Music Festival this year.

- C. Alamo MAC- Anne Struthers reported that the MAC will be holding their monthly meeting tomorrow Tuesday, June 2, 2015. Jen Quallick mentioned that the Alamo Mac will be revisiting the review of the plans for the new fire station at the corner of Miranda Avenue and Stone Valley Road.

8. **Police Report**

- A. CHP Officer Pruitt: Office Pruitt reported that some drivers were confused by the new lane striping on Danville Boulevard. Some northbound drivers are entering the safe lane at Orchard Lane on the south bound side of Danville boulevard. He also reminded the committee if the community had specific traffic concerns that he could be contacted by his email: jpruitt@CHP.ca.gov.
- B. Deputy Jesus Topete: The May 2015 Monthly Report was presented. Deputy Topete reported that there were four burglaries in Alamo during the month of May. The burglaries occurred on the following streets: Roundhill Road, Davey Crocket Court, Ridgewood Road and Stone Valley Way. He also reported that there was 122 Calls for Service. Deputy Topete reported that the "If I were a Thief Program" covered 93 streets during the month of April. Deputy Topete wanted to remind all Alamo residents to keep their homes and vehicles secure to further deter future burglaries. He also reminded the community that if you encounter suspicious activity you can contact the Sheriff's office on its non-emergency number 925-646-2441. For emergencies call 911.
