Alamo Police District P-2B Advisory Committee Minutes for June 4, 2012 Meeting

CALL TO ORDER Meeting called to order by Joe Motta at 5:05 PM.

ROLL CALL Members Present: Diane Barley, Barbara Cappa, JoAnn Hirsch, Karen McPherson, Ces Ciatti, and Joe Motta. Sadly, Nancy Dommes has resigned from the Board. Members agreed to take turns handling the duties of secretary in the future.

1. PUBLIC COMMENT Wendy Nacamy, a teacher from Stone Valley Middle School commented on the dangers her students face when they are riding their bikes to and from school on the north side of Stone Valley road near the southbound exit as well as the northbound entrance to Interstate 680. Members of the board agreed that it is a dangerous area. Charlie Eckwall, an Alamo resident and retired peace officer, spoke of his appreciation of the traffic safety and control efforts by the Sheriff's office, CHP and the P-2B.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Minutes of the last meeting was approved without change.

3. TREASURER'S REPORT : The treasurer's report was given to the board members. P-2B fund balance is \$453,542.18, and the traffic fund is \$40,400.41.

4. COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION REPORTS RELATING TO P-2B : None..

5. POLICE REPORT: Dep. Michael Carson provided a detailed report of the activities for the last month. He is now spending a day or two a week on his bicycle. He is very involved in our community, and by all appearances, the Board is pleased with the job he is doing for our community. He is also flexing his time so he can attend future public events, such as the Music\Movie in the Park, without putting in for overtime. The flexible time schedule will also allow Deputy Carson to maintain visibility within the community at different times of the day, which the Board believes will be an effective deterrent.

6. AGENDA ITEMS

A. Deputy Carson's bicycle service belt was ordered at less than originally estimated.

B. Review of the P-2B charter and the priorities of the P-2B deputy were tabled until the next meeting so that Donna Maxwell can send out a draft proposal to the Board.

C. Updates on official shirt, ball caps, and food for volunteers at sanctioned events: Lt. Grottkau will be ordering shirts and ball caps next month and the board voted unanimously to recommend a food and beverage allowance for the volunteers who be working at the Alamo Music Festival this summer not to exceed \$300.
