CALL TO ORDER Meeting called to order by Joe Motta at 5:10 PM.

1. PUBLIC COMMENT None

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Minutes of the last meeting was approved with a minor grammatical change.

3. TREASURER'S REPORT : The treasurer's report was given to the board members. P2B fund balance for July is \$472,954.90, and the traffic fund is \$40,400.41.

4. COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION REPORTS RELATING TO P2-B :

5. POLICE REPORT: Officer Brewer reported that CHP investigated 6 traffic collisions in June, including 1-DUI and 1-stolen vehicle (person arrested was from Castro Valley). In July CHP investigated 4 traffic collisions, including 1-DUI and 2 arrests. No turn on red at Stone Valley continues to be an issue. CHP will be concentrating again at Livorna Road once school starts. Officer Brewer will not be able to attend the next meeting. Deputy Carson submitted his monthly reports for June and July. Motion to approve expenditure of \$300 for Junior Deputy stickers was approved. Deputy Carson is adjusting to his variable schedule and feeling immersed in his position. He continues to spend a day or two on his bicycle.
