- D. Tree Permit Application (TR13-0043) has been submitted requesting approval of a tree permit to remove one code protected Coast Redwood tree of approximately 83" diameter due to the tree growing adjacent to the existing single-family residence. The property is located at 5 Deodar Lane, Alamo.

This project includes a Small Lot Design Review for a proposed residential addition, and modification to Tree Permit #TP13-0026 to remove two code protected trees (Tree #52, a 34-inch Monterey Pine, and Tree #50, a 13-inch Valley Oak) and to work within the drip-line of one code protected tree (Tree#57, a 7-inch Valley Oak). The property is located at 200 Valley Oaks Drive and 2208 Nelda Way, Alamo.
