District II Staff Update

3. PUBLIC COMMENT (3 minutes/speaker)

Pursuant to the Brown Act, this time is provided for members of the public and community groups to address the committee on matters within the committee's jurisdiction and <u>not on the agenda</u>. An opportunity will be provided as part of each agenda item for public comment on the item. Time allowed for each individual is three minutes. The Chair will recognize only those speakers who have filled out and turned in a speaker card.

4. PRESENTATIONS

- A. Updates on Hap Magee Ranch Park, with regard to the parking lot speed lumps and large dog park survey to community about turf replacement options, provided by Maintenance Supervisor David Casteel.
- B. San Ramon Valley Fire Protection District, Assistant Chief of Operations, Derek Krause, provided an update to the MAC about the progress of the new fence around Station 32's property.

With feedback from the neighbors, AIA and the MAC the fire department selected the fencing option most preferred by all and states that this fence will not only improve the appearance of the site, but provide for security as well. Krause offered a "big thank you," to ACE Hardware for handling the labor of the fencing project, free of charge. With regard to moving forward with the construction of Fire Station 32, Krause advised that the department is working through the financials and still plan to move forward with the new station.

5. NEW BUSINESS

- A. Development Plan (DP13-3023), has been submitted requesting approval for a small lot design review to determine neighborhood compatibility for the construction of a new two story single family residence on a vacant lot, as a result of letters from neighbors. The property is located at 173 South Via Lucia, Alamo.
 - Action requested: receive application, take public comment, discuss
 - Make recommendation to Supervisor Andersen

Motion for approval: Passed 3/2 (Mick, Struthers)

- B. Pre-application Review (PR13-0001) has been submitted in search of feedback from the MAC and community members. The applicant is in the process of determining the feasibility of changing the General Plan on his property from Single-Family Very Low Density (SV) (0.2-0.9 units per net acre) to Single-Family Low Density (SL) (1.0-2.9 units per acre), changing the zoning from R-40 (40,000 sq. ft. minimum lot size) to R-20 (20,000 sq. ft. minimum lot size) and subdividing the lot into two parcels. The property is located at 195 Vernal Drive, Alamo.
 - Action requested: receive application, take public comment, discuss
 - Make recommendation to Supervisor Andersen

No vote taken, feedback only from MAC members. MAC members were not supportive of a General Plan amendment for a single piece of property, suggested applicant work to persuade neighbors and County Planning that a change in the General Plan would be suitable for neighborhood.

- C. Variance Permit Application (VR13-1021) has been submitted requesting approval of a variance permit for a side yard setback of 6'0" (where a minimum of 15' is required) for a second-story addition and reconfiguration of roof pitch. This application includes a small lot design review for neighborhood compatibility to size, location, height and design. The property is located at 2631 Danville Boulevard, Alamo.
 - Action requested: receive application, take public comment, discuss
 - Make recommendation to Supervisor Andersen

Motion for approval, with stipulation that applicant add obscure glass to neighbor Weldon's side (also known as loft side) and that additional landscaping and/or lattice be added as a privacy buffer. Passed 4/1 (Mick)

- D. Development Plan (DP13-3029) has been submitted requesting design review approval for the construction of a new 594 square foot pavilion with fire place, on a substandard size lot. The property is located at 111 Regent Place, Alamo.
 - Action requested: receive application, take public comment, discuss
 - Make recommendation to Supervisor Andersen

- E. Land Use Permit (LP11-2049) has been submitted requesting approval to update an existing cell site and renew (LP01-2077), to include upgrade 2 equipment cabinets, 2 panel antennas and associated equipment and cabling. The property is located at: 1241 Laverock Lane, Alamo
 - Action requested: receive application, take public comment, discuss
 - Make recommendation to Supervisor Andersen

Motion for approval: Denied, without prejudice 5/0; applicant is welcome to return to MAC with application, once hillside repaired/enhanced as previously agreed; trees and shrubs along ridgeline to conceal cell site.

- F. Land Use Permit (LP13-2092) has been submitted requesting approval of a modification to County File #LP02-2107 to remove the existing pole and antennas, and replace them with a new 71-foot tall monopine pole, nine 8-foot antennas, six remote radio units (RRUs), three surge arrestors and new conduit. The site address is located at 1241 Laverock Lane, Alamo; adjacent to the 680 freeway.
